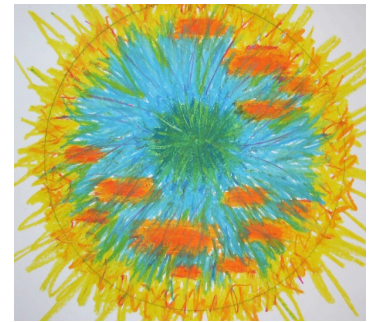
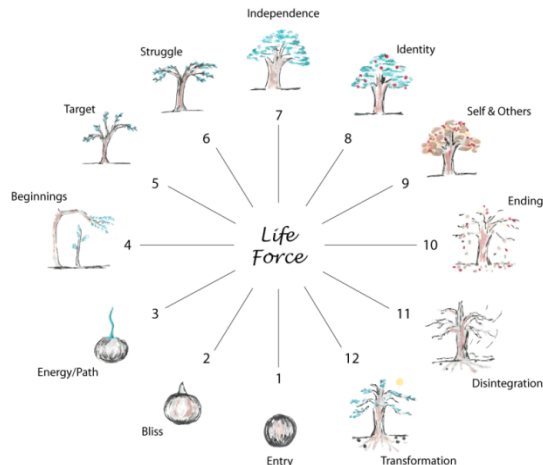

## WHAT IS THE MARI?

### (MANDALA ASSESSMENT RESEARCH INSTRUMENT)

- A powerful tool that reveals strengths as well as blocks. The mandala based instrument bypasses the ego and allows for insight and personal discoveries.
- Based on the newest theories in Positive Psychology and Evolutionary Biology and Psychology
- Based on symbols that predate language, culture and time. Jung believed the mandala was the “ultimate tool” for understanding the psyche.
- Joan Kellogg, ATR, building on Jung, developed a way to understand mandalas systematically and recognized that mandalas could be equated to the developmental stages of life.

Jill Zikmund’s professional experiences are grounded in traditional assessment and therapy approaches in clinical and administrative levels in inpatient, outpatient, outpatient, and public school settings. In addition to being a Certified MARI Teacher for 10 years, Jill is a Licensed Professional Counselor in both Ohio and Pennsylvania and has a private practice in Sharon PA.
